Good morning,

I am trusting that these meetings are progressing well and leading toward reworking each AD-T on the fast track to incorporate AB 928 CalGETC adjustments.

I have one specific concern I hope you can ensure is addressed: In the Elementary Teacher Preparation pathway, the Math for Teachers course is expected, yet is not currently eligible for CalGETC because of UC objections. This results in Elementary Teachers being required to take two math courses, which (as a mathematician myself) is good for their souls, but runs counter to the intentions of SB1440, AB928, etc. The best solution would be to add this course to CalGETC, along with the second semester of it which is recommended in the AA-T. As a secondary option, it would be helpful if the AA-T were to specify either statistics or Math for Liberal Arts as a UC-approved, CalGETC listed option within the AA-T in Elementary Teacher Preparation.
